Dear Parents and Carers,

Many thanks for all your ongoing support this term. Your child now has Junior school log in details for Purple Mash, TTRS and Accelerated Reader. These can be found at the front of their reading diary. Please could you continue to support us with accessing these at home if you can. Our school does ask that each child reads for 15 minutes per day and that an adult signs their reading diary at least 3 times per week. The diary is also a great way to message your child's class teacher if you are unable to see them at the start or end of the school day. We check these at least three times per week and your child is able to change their reading book once they have completed the AR quiz. This can be done at home or at school.

As we no longer set weekly homework, please could you support your child in accessing TTRS once a week if possible. We ensure there is time in the week at school for this too, but the more practice, the better!

And finally, just a gentle reminder that our PE days this half term are Monday and Thursday. We tend to go outside for football on Thursday, so, if possible, please send your child in jogging bottoms.
